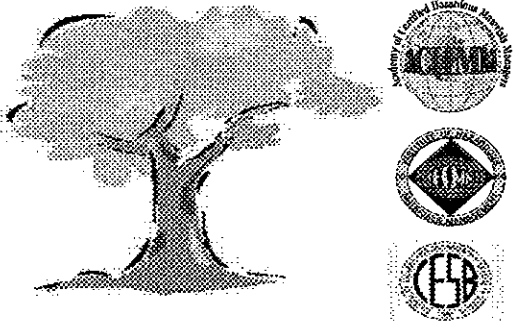

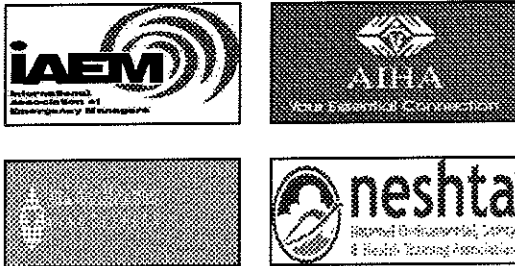
CHMM Family Tree
